 - Group: Bengali, Hindi, or any regional language

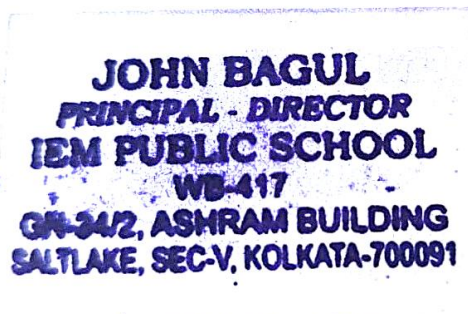
Important Instructions:

Categories

1. Solo Singing – One participant with maximum 2 student accompanists or with track
(Note: Except Film Songs / Pure Classical genre)
2. Group Singing – 4 to 6 participants with maximum 2 student accompanists or with track
(Note: Theme should be - either Patriotic or Regional Folk)

Track if any, should be mailed as MP3 Format 7 days prior to the competition date with proper labelling. Participants are also requested to carry their tracks in a pen drive as MP3 Format on the day of competition to avoid any last moment technical glitches.

Language of Performance

- Solo :- Bengali or Hindi
- Group Song :- Bengali, Hindi or any other regional language
