Subject: **ISC Examination Regulations – Effective from Examination Year 2027**

**Dear Parents (Class XI & XII),
Greetings from IEM Public School!**

This is to inform you that the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) has introduced significant changes in the ISC (Class XII) Examination Regulations, which will be applicable to students appearing for the **ISC Examination 2027 onwards**.

The important changes are as follows:

- **Revised Pass Criteria:** Students will now be required to secure a passing standard in **English/Modern English and four elective subjects** (i.e., a total of **five subjects**) to qualify for the ISC Examination. Earlier, passing in English and three elective subjects was sufficient.
- **Equal Importance to All Subjects:** As all five subjects will now be considered for qualification, students are advised **not to adopt selective study habits** and should give equal attention to every subject.
- **Promotion to Class XII:** Promotion from Class XI to Class XII will be based on the cumulative performance throughout the academic year. Students must obtain **at least 35% marks in each of the five subjects (including English/Modern English)** and maintain a **minimum attendance of 75%** as per CISCE regulations.
- **SUPW & Community Service:** A passing grade in **SUPW and Community Service** (internally assessed by the school) remains compulsory for qualification.
- We have to conduct multiple rounds of revision to help students cope with the additional subject. One more subject means an additional 100 marks, so we have started conducting extra classes well in advance.
- We also have introduced improvement classes after regular school hours so students can clear doubts with teachers and seek extra academic support.
- Our school has also increased the number of MCQs sent to students for regular practice.
- We are stressing the importance of regular attendance with the addition of another subject at the ISC in the School.

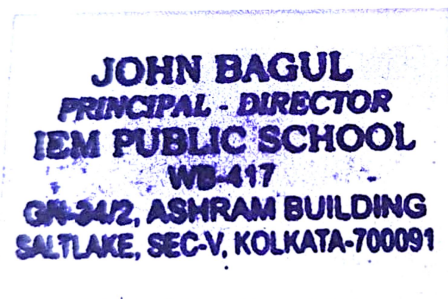
Parents are requested to encourage their wards to maintain regular attendance, participate sincerely in all assessments, and prepare consistently in **every subject** throughout the academic session.
